The United Graduate School of Agricultural Science (UGSAS) held (Wednesday, November 10) "The 9th IC-GU12 Roundtable Meeting" with the participation of "International Consortium of Universities in South and Southeast Asia for the Doctoral Education in Agricultural Science and Biotechnology (IC-GU 12; comprising 20 universities from 9 countries in South and Southeast Asia including Japan)." In the Roundtable Meeting, 27 academic staff from 16 partner

universities discussed the state of online classes conducted at each university and online educational collaboration among faculty and staff.

In the two-day, on-and-offline Symposium, Head organizer by Prof. Toshiyuki Ohtsuka, River Basin Research Center, invited four respected researchers, Assoc. Prof. Miyako Nakagawa, Nagoya University, Assoc. Prof. Sasitorn Poungparn, Chulalongkorn University, Assoc. Prof. Atsuhiro Iio, Shizuoka University and Dr. So Hanaoka, Director, Hokkaido Regional Breeding Office, Forest Tree Breeding Center gave their keynote speeches over forest ecology and management. It was followed by presentations by 15

researchers and discussions. Many of UGSAS alumni and researchers in IC-GU12 member university joined and active Q&A session was conducted.


The 6th International Conference on Climate Change (ICCC) (May 25 on online)

The United Graduate School of Agricultural Science (UGSAS) and Sebelas Maret University (Indonesia) jointly hosted the 6th International Conference on Climate Change 2021(ICCC) on Tuesday, May 25, 2021 through Zoom video conferencing platform. The theme of the conference was; "Environmental Perspective in Understanding the Effects of Climate Change on Immune System Modulation in Organisms."

From the UGSAS, Professor Ken Hiramatsu (UGSAS Dean) and Professor Masato Yayota attended. After an opening speech by Professor Hiramatsu, Professor Yayota gave his keynote speech titled, "Climate

Change and Cattle: Heat stress, Immune system and Production." It was followed by six presentations by invited guests. They included Professor A.H.M. Nurun Nabi from the University of Dhaka (Bangladesh) who is a UGSAS graduate, and Professor Mohammad Nasir Uddin from Texas A&M Health Science Center (USA), etc. A total of 117 people made presentations as keynote speakers or lecturers for multiple sessions. In total, 223 people attended the conference.






After an opening speech by Professor Ken Hiramatsu (UGSAS Dean), Professor Emeritus Fumiaki Suzuki delivered a keynote speech titled, "Possible Prevention & Protection Against Infection Diseases." Including Dr. Suzuki, five speakers gave keynote speeches and 140 participants made their presentations at 10 different parallel sessions. Two hundred seventy people joined the 7th conference in total. Since its launching, ICCC

members have been closely

monitoring impacts of climate change on human lives and environment and continue to address environmental issues. In the 7th conference, participants discussed climate change from various perspectives such as environment, agriculture, law, society, economy, culture, etc. While the pandemic is still raging around the globe, holding international conferences is not always an easy option, but under a strong leadership of Associate Professor Komariah from Universitas Sebelas Maret, two conferences were successfully held in AY 2021, both of which became valuable venues for people to exchange their opinions.
