MESSAGE from DEAN

My fifth year as Dean of the Graduate School of Agricultural Science is about to end. The term of office was previously limited to a maximum of four years, so this is an exceptionally long time, but the road to our goal of becoming an international center for agricultural research is far from complete.

The biggest topic in 2024 is certainly the adoption of the Spring Project by the Tokai National Higher Education and Research System in which Gifu University is involved. Nearly 30 students in our graduate school have received scholarships from this project. We would like to express our gratitude to Professor Koyama, the representative of the program at Gifu University, and other people concerned. Another significant development is that the Cotutelle programs with the University of Lille, France and Vytautas Magnus University, Lithuania, have started to operate. One French student immediately enrolled in the program, and two more students are expected to apply in the next academic year. This Cotutelle program is operated in a similar way to the Joint Degree Program, and since it offers significant advantages to both parties, we have begun exchanging opinions with the IC-GU12 partner universities about introducing the program.

In November, we co-hosted an international conference on climate change with Sebelas Maret University, which was attended by many researchers and graduates from IC-GU12 partner universities, and we were able to renew old friendships. I believe that it is one of the roles of our graduate school to improve the research capabilities of faculty, students, and graduates through international exchange. In the next year, the VI Asia Symposium on Quality Management in Postharvest Systems is scheduled to be held at Shizuoka University, and we plan to cosponsor the Symposium to support the faculty and students involved and to strengthen cooperation with the IC-GU12 partner universities.

We would like to ask for your continued support for the development of our graduate school.


The 10th International Conference on Climate Change
