The United Graduate School of Agricultural Science (UGSAS: PhD course) held "The 7th UGSAS-GU Roundtable" with the attendance of IC-GU 12^{*} member universities on October 8, 2019. On following October 9 and 10, UGSAS hosted "The 7th UGSAS-GU International Symposium on a New Era in Food Science and Technology 2019" to introduce activities of young researchers (UGSAS alumni) at their respective research institutes and organizations overseas. Both events were held at the UGSAS building on campus. On October 8, approximately twenty academic staff (including those who serve as liaisons) from seven member universities discussed the progress and challenges of double PhD

degree programs, current status and future outlook of joint laboratory operations between UGSAS and the member universities. ***IC-GU12:**" International

For two days from October 9 to 10, a total of 147 people attended"The 7th UG-SAS-GU International Symposium on a New Era in Food Science and Technology 2019." Under the theme of science and technology development in time of changing needs of people for food, four international researchers delivered a keynote speech, which was followed by sixteen researchers' presentations.

In the afternoon of October 10, "Student Poster Session" was co-hosted between Gifu University Rearing Program for Basin Water Environmental Leaders, and the Indian Institute of Technology, Guwahati (IITG). Thirty-four students out of 51 participants made their poster presentations, of them, seven students were awarded the best poster prize for 2019. As a part of Gifu University 70th anniversary events, both the roundtable and the symposium were held concurrently with the "Gifu Joint Degree Symposium 2019" (October 7 and 8) organized by Gifu University Organization for Promotion of Glocalization (GU-GLOCAL). In addition, on October 9 and 10, "The 4th International Joint Meeting

of Advanced Global Program in Conjunction" was hosted by the Faculty of Engineering in parallel with the roundtable and symposium. Dr. Gary D. Christian from University of Washington was invited to speak at the special open lecture as a guest speaker.

MESSAGE from DEAN



First of all, the major chair of the International Joint PhD Program in Food Science and Technology between Gifu University and Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati (IITG) launched in April, 2019, with two students enrolled at the IITG home school. In addition, two important events were organized as commemorative memorial projects for the 70th anniversary of Gifu University. First, we held the international research symposium on food science titled "The International Symposium on a New Era in Food Science and Technology 2019" on 9th to 10th 2019 in the campus of Gifu University. Second, on 18th to 19th November, we cohosted the international symposium titled "Climate Change: The Risk to Sustainability and Environmental Issues" at Gadjah Mada University in Indonesia, with Sebelas Maret University. Such activities have been making steady results and this fiscal year we were able to accept excellent entrants of 21 students (of which 13 were international students). The 4th International Conference on Climate Change (ICCC) (November 18-19)

On November 18 to 19, UGSAS held an international conference entitled "Climate Change: The Risk to Sustainability and Environmental Issues" in collaboration with Sebelas Maret University, Gadjah Mada University and Ikatan Ahli Lingkungan Hidup Indonesia (IALHI). Dr. Komariah of Sebelas Maret University has served a chairman

consecutively. From Gifu University, 7 delegates attended the conference. Dr. Fumiaki Suzuki Vice President, Executive Director for International Affairs and Public Relations, gave a welcome speech at the opening ceremony. In the main conference, prof. Senge delivered a keynote speech titled, "Climate Change Impact on Irrigation." He spoke about possible effects on irrigation by climate change. His



speech was followed by presentations on possible impacts by climate change and countermeasures given by the following guest speakers: Prof. Md. Abdul Mojid from Bangladesh Agricultural University (Bangladesh), Assoc. Prof. Nguyen Thu Hien from Thuyloi University (Vietnam). A total of 125 people attended the conference. The outcomes of the 4th ICCC will be edited into academic papers. Already 62 papers finished peer reviews, and are scheduled to be posted on the internet and registered by Scopus* around January 2020. We hope that achievements of the ICCC will help researchers and engineers around the world advance their research on climate change for the future.
